Half term Break

We break up for the half term holiday on Friday 15th February at 1:30pm and return to school on Monday, 25th February at 8:30am.

I would like to take this opportunity in reminding you that all pupils are expected to wear full school uniform at all times. Any pupil arriving at school in incorrect uniform will be placed in internal support and will have their lessons separately from other peers. Parent/carers will be called to bring school uniform in. Nails are to be kept short and nail varnish is not allowed.

If we have any suspicions that a pupil is under the influence of drugs or alcohol we will be contacting the parent/carers to come in to collect their child. In addition to this, there will be a return to school meeting arranged before your child will be allowed back at school. Pupils that have been identified will have to go on a joint program with the Young Persons Drug and Alcohol Team (YPDAT).

All mobile phones must be handed in at the start of the day and they will be handed back at the end of the day. Should students be found to have their phones on them during the school day, they will be confiscated, parents rung and asked to come in to school to collect the phone.
